

Our signature annual event, Food & Folly brings the spirit of Mobile's carnival season to the fall. Attendees enjoy cuisine samples from local restaurants, live music by the legendary Excelsior Band, wine, craft beer and spirits tastings, a silent auction, wine pull, and much more!

This year's event is planned for Thursday, September 21, at Fort Whiting Auditorium in downtown Mobile. We expect 300 guests for the event, including area business professionals and influential community members.

At the end of the night, a "People's Choice Award" is presented to the restaurant/caterer who garners the most votes from attendees. We also award a separate "People's Choice" in the dessert category.

There is no cost to participate as a restaurant or caterer in Food & Folly, other than your generous in-kind donation of food, time and staffing.

Details and Requirements:

- We will provide all restaurant/catering participants with one (1) 8-foot table, complete with linens and signage for your business. Power will also be available, if needed.
- Participants should bring samples for a minimum of 300 guests.
- Participants are required to provide any necessary serving ware for your dish (including, but not limited to, plates, bowls, napkins and utensils) as well as any desired promotional materials or decorations. Note: Please do not decorate with Mardi Gras beads as we use them for "People's Choice Award" voting.
- Event setup will take place between 4:45-5:45 p.m. on the day of the event.
- Participants should plan to have staff members present at the event until its conclusion at 9:30 p.m.

Participating Brewery/Distillery: In-Kind

Another critical component to Food & Folly are craft beer and spirit tastings, which couldn't happen without the generosity of our area's breweries and distilleries.

There is no cost to participate as a brewery or distillery in Food & Folly, other than your inkind donation of products. Participants should provide enough product to serve as samples (beer--5 oz. pour, spirits--1 oz. shot) for a minimum of 300 guests. You are welcome to join us at the event to help serve your product, or you could alternatively offer tasting notes, if possible.

Silent Auction Item(s): In-Kind

An exciting part of Food & Folly each year is our silent auction, which generates a lot of buzz as well as contributions to our organization. Our silent auction takes place both online and in-person.
